

It also frames a set of alternative social practices that allows for connections to be made between feminist politics among immigrant women in Britain, women of color in the United States, and Muslim women in Iran, Egypt, Pakistan, and Canada; the work of subaltern studies in India, the Philippines, and Mexico; and antiracist social movements in North and South America, the Caribbean, and Europe. These connections displace modes of opposition traditionally defined in relation to the modern state and enable a rethinking of political practice in the era of global capitalism. Representing a broad cross-section of academic disciplines, and theoretical and activist positions, The Politics of Culture in the Shadow of Capital will interest a wide range of scholars working in cultural studies, postcolonial theory, geography, trans-national studies, and anthropology.
