There has come about in physiology within the last ten years the use of two new words, anabolic and katabolic. The justification for the employment of these words is mainly to be found in recent experiments made on the heart which show that certain nerves tend to help the nourishment of the heart and are in the old sense of the word, true trophic nerves, while certain other nerves, when active, tend to exhaust the heart and to prevent or hinder its nutrition. Experiments first made on the heart by Gaskell have since been extended to muscles and to other organs, so that the physiology of to-day is largely a question of anabolic and katabolic phenomena.
